Successful applicants will form a unified cohort and will be expected to participate in EPIC's networking and educational activities, present their research at various EPIC research events and provide a yearly activity report and exit survey. Awardees will also be highlighted on EPIC's various communication channels including, but not limited to, website, social media and newsletter. Awardees are required to acknowledge EPIC's support in publications, presentations, and communications resulting from their project.

An application for the EPIC Doctoral Award will not be considered finalized until a completed Supervisor Form and Co-supervisor form, if applicable is received. A link to the demographic survey will be provided to the supervisor and co-supervisor(s) upon receipt of the Supervisor Form.
