 - Proposal description (*maximum 500 words*) and budget justification (*not included in the word limit*)
 - Applicant CV (Canadian Common CV style preferred)
 - Applicant Academic Transcript (*graduate students only*) (official transcript not required)
- Letters of Support
 - Primary supervisor letter (maximum one page)
 - Host supervisor letter (maximum one page)
- Demographic Survey
 - All applicants will be asked to complete our demographic survey. Link to be provided. Note that completion of the survey is mandatory for applicants and supervisors. While this survey is required, there is an option to select "Prefer not to answer" for all questions.

All materials should be easily legible, in a minimum of 11-point font with standard document margins (top/bottom: 2.5cm, left/right: 1.9cm).

EPIC will be reviewing applications and awarding funding on a **rolling basis up to May 31, 2024 or until all available funds have been disbursed**.
