EPIC New Connections Grants support innovative projects that are fostered through crossdisciplinary collaboration across at least two research groups. Successful proposals will feature joint lead investigators from different university divisions and/or EPIC partner institutions coming together for their first significant research collaboration. The joint investigators will tackle an infectious disease research question by innovative applying methodologies that capitalize on their different areas of expertise for impactful outcomes.

 - Plain Language Summary (maximum 250 words)
 - o Project Proposal (maximum 1500 words, references are not included in the word limit).
 - o EDI Statement (maximum 250 words)
 - *List of collaborators* (if applicable)
 - Statement of collaboration (maximum 250 words)
 - *CV* for each of the joint lead investigator (Canadian Common CV style preferred)
 - *Budget* (1-page breakdown and justification of the total budget requested)
- Demographic Survey
 - All investigators will be asked to complete our demographic survey. Link to be provided. Note that completion of the survey is mandatory for applicants and supervisors. While this survey is required, there is an option to select "Prefer not to answer" for all questions.

All materials should be easily legible, in a minimum of 11-point font with standard document margins (top/bottom: 2.5 cm, left/right: 1.9 cm).
